

CONSIDER BEING A FOSTER PARENT

EMERGENCY HOME/SHORT-TERM HOME

A home that will take in a foster kid(s) on a short term basis. The home can decide the length of time and could even be just a weekend. There is a great need for this in Skagit County as many kids are put up in hotels for lack of Emergency Homes.

HOMES FOR CHILDREN AGES:

- 0-5 years (daycare is provided for working foster parents)
- 6-11 years (need someone who can advocate for their educational needs)
- 12-18 years (need a trusted adult who can mentor/coach them)

HOMES FOR CHILDREN WITH DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES

Provide care for children with mental and/or physical delays such as Down Syndrome, Autism, etc.

HOMES FOR SIBLING GROUPS

Keeping siblings together is an important way to minimize the trauma experienced by children when removed from their homes. While some sibling groups are comprised of 2 children in close ages, other sibling groups can consist of 3 or more children ranging in ages from infants to teens.

FOSTER-ADOPT/ADOPTIVE HOMES

There are hundreds of children in Washington State waiting for a pre-adoptive home or are legally free and waiting to be adopted. In the majority of cases, the state reimburses your adoption fees.
